EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Traditional

Equipment requirements for Traditional Pistol and Rifle are the same as in the past. An 1887 Lever Action, 1897 Pump Action or Model 12 Pump Action Shotgun may be used.

Modern

Equipment requirements for Modern Pistol and Rifle are the same as in the past. An 1887 Lever Action, 1897 Pump Action or Model 12 Pump Action Shotgun may be used.

Open

This category is not found in Historic 3 Gun (H3G) or SASS rules. This is specific to Cowtown. Pistol requirements for Open are the same as for Traditional and Modern. Either may be used. A .38 Caliber Lever Rifle may be used. An 1887 Lever Action, 1897 Pump Action or Model 12 Pump Action Shotgun may be used.

Teddy Roosevelt and **Doughboy** categories are not offered at Cowtown because of distance limitations.

STAGE CONVENTIONS are a mix of H3G and SASS rules.

New stage conventions specific to Cowtown are as follows:

- Shotgun targets are Comstock. That is, a missed knockdown target may be reengaged before the next firearm string is engaged.
- Your 1911 pistol may start a stage in either Condition 1 or Condition 3. A competitor ALWAYS leaves the loading table with the 1911 empty. After staging long guns as appropriate, the TO will instruct the shooter to load and make ready the shooter's choice of Condition 1 or Condition 3. The TO will then give the start commands and start the timer on the stage. If starting in Condition 1, insert a loaded magazine, rack the slide to load a round in the chamber, IMMEDIATELY engage the safety and then holster your pistol. When appropriate to use your 1911 in the stage, unholster, disengage the safety once the muzzle crosses 45 degrees from horizontal, and engage the targets per stage instructions. If starting in Condition 3, after inserting a loaded magazine, holster your pistol and engage the targets per stage instructions.
- If the stage directions require you to move from position to position with your 1911 pistol, you may do so with a round in the chamber, the hammer cocked and your finger VISIBLY out of the trigger guard.

All other conventions remain the same.
